Closure of Port of Looe to All Leisure Craft and Recreational Vessels

All Water Users are advised that **until further notice, use of recreational vessels will not be permitted within the jurisdiction of the Port of Looe** (*Jurisdiction of Looe Harbour Commissioners being defined as: All Commissioners property and navigable waters up river of the Southern end of the Banjo Pier, together with all waters South of the Banjo Pier and within an arc 846 yards outside the seaward end of the Banjo Pier*).

For the purpose of this NTM, the term *'recreational vessel'* includes but is not limited to the following; sailing boats, gigs, paddleboards, kayaks, jet skis, kitesurf, windsurf boards or any other form of vessel being used for recreational purposes.
